Summer has arrived – we were bathed in beautiful sunshine this week and Year 5/6 have enjoyed picnicking on the field at lunchtime.

As the warmer weather arrives please make sure you have applied sunscreen to your child before they come to school – it should last through play and lunchtimes. We are unable to apply cream to them. If you have a child with particularly fair skin (my overriding memories of primary school are having a burnt face, legs and arms after PE lessons!) please send cream in with them clearly named which they can apply to themselves under supervision. A water bottle will help keep them hydrated and a hat shade them from the sun. Please make sure the water bottle has in it just that – not juice or squash. All children's belongings need to be clearly labelled as, sure as eggs are eggs, they will take their things out onto the field and forget to bring them back.

Also, please ensure your child has their PE kit in school at all times. The teachers will take advantage of any lovely weather and do more sports/PE outside. The children should be wearing black shorts and a house colour t-shirt and trainers. Some of the girls are wearing "skorts" which are fine. The children should not be wearing football t-shirts of the club they support or leggings or tracksuit bottoms if the weather is warm. Thank you for your support in this.

Finally, please can I remind you that I am unable to authorise a child's absence from school unless there are exceptional circumstances. There is guidance on our website. Nearly every absence request I receive has to be unauthorised as the exceptional criteria is not met.

Sleep in children with brain conditions – one day conference

Cerebra, the charity dedicated to helping families with children with brain conditions discover a better life together, are holding a one day conference on sleep in children with brain conditions which will disseminate the findings of recent sleep research and consider the implications for parents, carers and professionals.

THE UNIVERSITY OF WARWICK

Are you the mother, father, or caregiver of a child aged between 4 and 15 years, 11 months who has a learning disability?

Our 1000 families study, carried out at the University of Warwick, is exploring the experiences of family members who live with a child with a learning disability.

The study has recently received permission from the NHS Research Ethics Committee to extend the age range. We can now include children in the study if they are between the age of 4 and 15 years and 11 months (previously 4 and 11 years and 11 months). We heard from a number of families who would have liked to take part, but were unable to because their child was between the ages of 12 and 16 years. If this is you, we'd love to invite you to get involved.

We are really keen to survey at least one person in the family (especially, a mother and a father) to explore whether family members have similar or different experiences and capture the experience of the whole family. We want to make this the largest study ever of families of children with learning disability in the UK and help shape future information and support.
