PARKING We have, this week had numerous complaints from residents and neighbours regarding the inconsiderate parking in the surrounding roads of a few parents. We have therefore spoken to our Community Police Support Officers, who in turn are speaking to Hampshire Constabulary regarding patrolling the surrounding area on a more frequent basis. Our crossing patrol is increasingly concerned about the safety of children coming into school in the mornings as parents are parking and turning in the entrance to school in front of the school gates. Please can we ask parents not to park in front of or close to the school gates. Thank you for your support in all these matters.

JEWELLERY/UNIFORM Copies of the uniform policy are available from the school office, but:-

- Black/brown shoes – not boots/trainers.
