I have loved being a teacher again and helping children unpick tricky questions and work out how to answer SATS style questions most effectively. I also want to say to our children "You are not your test score. You are so much more!" There are lots of important things that SATS can't measure: They can't measure the love, joy and responsibility that you work so hard to show to others all the time and when it goes wrong (as it inevitably will because we are not perfect!) you try so hard to put right.

These are the things SATS can't measure:

- the imagination, curiosity and creativity you demonstrate in your thinking every day
- gifts of love, compassion and care you demonstrate to those people around you
- the joy you show when learning about the things that are really important to you
- the effort you put in every day, day after day
- your success because learning is a journey throughout life and continual practice and hard work will lead to progress
- what a good person you are – your friendship, generosity, trust, hope and determination

So no matter how the tests go next week remember **YOU ARE NOT A TEST SCORE; YOU ARE SO MUCH MORE** and we are really proud of all the things that you are achieving now and will achieve in the future.

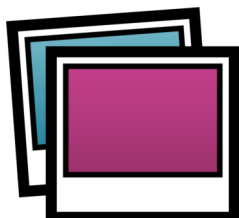
