PLEASE CHECK for HEAD LICE

We understand it is a continual request but we are still having reported incidents of head lice. Please thoroughly check your child and if affected ensure that appropriate treatment is given. Bed linen and pillows should also be deep cleaned to avoid re-infestation. Children do not need to be kept off school for head lice however they should be treated immediately upon discovery.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

This policy is intended to ensure that there are consistent and clear guidelines for school uniform, leading to a positive, shared identity leading to high expectations for presentation and appearance. Wearing uniform also ensures that children are safely and appropriately dressed whilst at school.

This is a reminder for all that everyday uniform is....

- grey/black trousers, shorts, skirt, culottes or pinafore dress, green and white stripe/check dress when the weather is warm
- white shirt or blouse or white/dark green polo shirt
- green sweatshirt or cardigan preferably with school logo
- grey/white socks
- grey/white/green/black tights



SHOES -

- Black, comfortable, low-heeled shoes .
- Boots of any description should not be worn during the school day.
- Trainers should not be worn in school except for PE

PE uniform should be in school at all times.

- house colour T-shirt (available with school logo) and shorts in black or green.
- trainers with soft soles.
- warm, plain dark coloured tracksuit for outdoor games (brand/designer names are discouraged)

For health and safety reasons, jewellery should not be worn for PE and studs worn in ears should be taped by the child or removed in advance.

General guidance on appearance:

- Long hair should be tied back at all times, with simple hair bands or scrunchies in school colours. Hair braids with beads are to be avoided.
- In general, jewellery should not be worn to school.
- Children with pierced ears may wear single plain stud earrings.
- Discreet watches may also be worn.
- Watches should be removed for PE.
- Valuables are brought into school at own risk.
- Children should not wear make-up or nail varnish at any time.
- Children are encouraged to take responsibility for all personal items of clothing.
- Lost property is held centrally and is displayed regularly for parents to claim.
- **All items of clothing must be named.**
