



## **Sports Premium Funding 2017-2018**

This year we will be focusing on creating an inclusive and engaging school culture through daily activity. We will provide various clubs that target groups of children who are less inclined to participate in physical activity. This year we are taking part in a range of festivals, in house and external competitions that cater for the needs of our children and challenge our elite performers.

This year to further develop Sport and PE provision at Rownhams, we aim to do this by

- Achieving Sainsbury's School Games Gold Mark
- Staff to provide diverse and quality assured extra-curricular clubs and residential opportunities.
- Increase participation of children in Level 1, Level 2 and Level 3 competitions
- Continue to develop PE teaching through continued professional development in P.E by accessing external training to ensure future development.
- Increased level of P.E throughout the school to ensure sufficient coverage and enriched learning opportunities.
- Pupil Sports Ambassadors to undertake training (PBed) and to lead lunchtime clubs/activities and develop their leadership skill through delivering P.E sessions and festivals.
- Promote outdoor spaces to engage pupils in play based activity.

External agencies to support children in developing their sport skills in preparation for competitions (gymnastics, dance and football) - £300

Specialist training to team teach and model good practice to staff to develop their CPD- £2400

New outdoor area to promote physical activity during playtimes and lunchtimes- £7737 (Spring allocation)

New resources for P.E to ensure inclusivity, quality and accessibility to meet the needs of pupils ages 4-11 years- £200

Coaching for Sports Day and medals Funding- £250

Training for Bronze Ambassadors -£100

Dance CPD for all staff- £390

Servicing of P.E equipment and tangle tree- £35

Hampshire P.E conference- £130
