



In the last week of term we held our second Parent and Carers Group. It was really positive and lovely to hear that parents feel that their children really enjoy school and the quality of provision we provide for them is really appreciated. Of course, there are always things we can do to improve so it was great to discuss suggestions and ways forward to do this. The notes from this meeting will follow in the next half term.

One of the things we talked about was resilience and how we teach children to manage failure. Since September 2018 we have been developing a 'Learning Button' approach to help children understand learning behaviours. We encourage children to push their learning buttons when things might be getting tough. They are as follows:

At Rownhams we are:

Effort Makers

We do our best 100% of the time, we persevere with our learning and take pride in all of our work.

Problem Solvers

We have a go and use our initiative. We can be logical and systematic and can make connections between ideas. We are curious and ask questions about the world around us. We use our imagination and think creatively.

Go Getters

We can work independently. We plan a way forward even when things get tough. We are resourceful, making use of what we have to hand. We are solution finders not excuse makers.

Reflective Learners

We know that mistakes can make us better. We are not afraid to get it wrong - it just means we are trying. We are reflective in our learning, always looking for ways to do things better. We listen and take on feedback from others and are resilient in the face of difficulties.

Risk takers

We take calculated risks and can express ourselves in many ways. We look for new ideas and try something different every day. We create, design and make.

Team Builders

We listen to the ideas of others and communicate clearly with each other. We share responsibility and work fairly, taking on a role when working in a team.

This remains in early stages of embedding in school but is something we will be developing over the next few terms!

End of Key Stage One SATs

Finally, I'd like to say well done to all of Year 2 children who have now finished their end of Key Stage One SATs! The children have been superb and demonstrated many of our learning buttons mentioned above. Huge thanks to all the members of staff involved. They were able to seamlessly plan in the tests so that the children were able to achieve their best without causing any undue pressure.

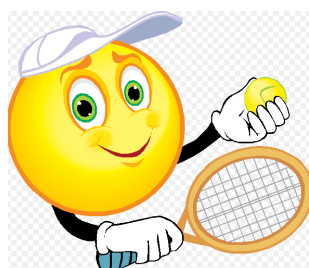

School Meal Prices from September 2019

Following the Executive Member for Children's Services Decision Day on 8 May 2019, it has been agreed that the price for a two course, hot school meal will rise by 4.3% in September 2019, from £2.30 to £2.40.

The revised charge reflects inflationary pressures associated with food costs and staff pay which rose by 6.4% in April 2019, when the hourly pay rate for catering assistants was increased nationally. Over 90% of the cost of a school meal covers food and staff costs, with related overheads accounting for the remainder. Supplying school meals at cost, keeps the price as low as possible for Hampshire residents and ensures they receive value for money.

It was also agreed that the price charged directly to schools for the meals which are funded by Universal Infant Free School Meals scheme will not be increased but will remain at the current price of £2.30, because the Government funding to schools is being maintained at £2.30 per meal for the 2019/20 academic year.

Where parents pay for meals, schools are requested to advise of the price change from September 2019.
