# Starting school in September

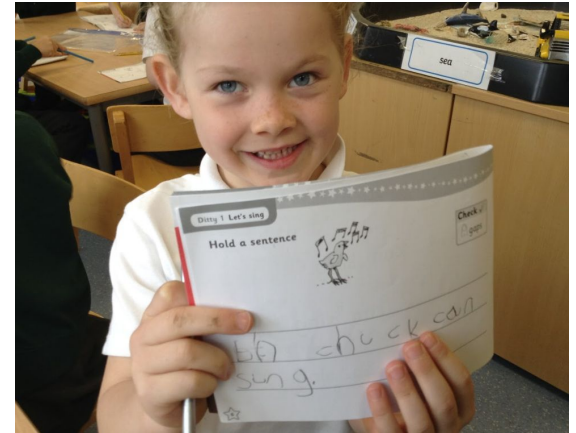

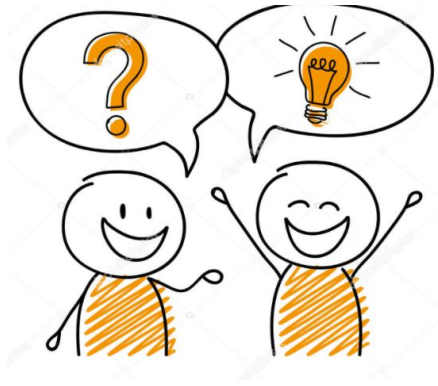
